 develop and implement school wide approach to teaching numeracy and literacy, with the use of
 feedback and short cycle data.

Our initiatives include

- Co-contribute school funds to engage a permanent teacher to ensure high staff retention and consistency of curriculum delivery and knowledge of the school improvement areas of Maths, Reading and Writing.
- Align staff expertise to the needs of identified student needs through targeted use of resourcing.
- Provide consistency of teachers to deepen contextual knowledge (poverty and trauma) to support the social, emotional and academic needs of students Support a large number of students who have trauma and other social and emotional needs.
- Employing a speech pathologist to more frequently support a large number of students who have identified speech lanaugage difficulties.
- Provide targeted staff capability building through coaching, professional development and engaging in a Peer Learning Community of best practice research and High Impact Teaching Strategies.
